2. Applicant must have a cumulative high school GPA of 2.0 or greater (High School Senior)
3. Applicant must have ACT score of 20 or better or SAT of 1020 or better (High School Senior)
4. Southern University Full-Time undergraduate student in good standing (2.0 GPA Cumulative or better)
5. Applicant must demonstrate community service activities.
6. Applicant must write a 500 word essay stating reason for attending Southern University, your goals and aspirations upon graduation and why you should be awarded scholarship?
